

What to Know Now for Student Camp at Lake Yale

We are just a few months away from Student Camp at Lake Yale (July 16–19), and we couldn't be more excited! Whether your student has attended before or this is their first time, we are prayerfully preparing for a week where students will take next steps in discovering and deepening their relationship with Jesus Christ.



Theme: First and Best

This year's theme is *First and Best*. God is first. He's not just first on a list of priorities, but the page every priority is written on. And because He is first, He went first. He gave His first and best through Jesus while we were a broken mess. Our hope is that every student leaves Student Camp having wrestled with one question: what or who is actually first in my life?

As they worship, dig into the Scriptures, and unpack next steps in Family Groups, we pray they encounter Jesus and respond to Him with their First and Best in every area of their lives.

❧ The Rivalry

Every student has been invited to compete in The Rivalry - our weeklong, camp-wide competition where squads go head-to-head in games, spirit, and creativity to win the title of **Top Squad**.

Throughout the week, students will earn points in three areas:

1. **Squad Swag** – showing up in creative team-themed outfits

2. **Squad Energy** – bringing enthusiasm, participation, and team support
3. **Squad Victories** – winning competitions and challenges

Each student will receive their team assignment closer to camp. We'll also provide more guidance on what to pack and how to prepare so your student can show up ready to represent their squad!

A Glimpse at the Daily Schedule

Daily rhythms at Student Camp include:

- Morning worship and main session
- Family Group time (Bible study & discussion) with students of the same grade and gender
- The Rivalry and free time in the afternoon
- Evening worship and campus gatherings
- Late Night themed experiences before lights out
